



Rudi had fallen prey to what seemed like a legitimate job opportunity in the Philippines, only to have his passport confiscated and find himself trapped in a scam operation alongside his friends, working without pay. "Anyone, regardless of their background or education, can become a victim of human trafficking," he reflects.

But he was found and rescued!

Because of your compassionate support last Christmas and throughout the year, we were able to help him move beyond the exploitation into healing. We were able to assist him in providing his testimony in court, raising public awareness about human trafficking, and finding a new job close to home.

Today, countless others around the world like Rudi wake up in freedom because you chose to act. Thank you!

Thank you for walking alongside survivors like Samara* as they work towards healing with determination and strength.

Because you walk with us, victims who once thought they might never see freedom are now building full, restored lives.

She was able to meet with an IJM team to help her set up a personalized aftercare plan, start therapy, and testify in the perpetrator's trial.

Now, she continues therapy and is making a better life for her and her family. Soon, she hopes to open her own flower shop or even become a pastry chef.


No matter where Samara's dreams will take her, one thing is for sure: she'll be taking every step forward in freedom thanks to compassionate justice-seekers like you.

- 1,300+ Victims & at-risk children safeguarded
- 370+ Survivors restored
- 368+ Law enforcement conducted operations
- 410+ Suspects arrested
- 240+ Offenders convicted
