“Engage Humbly” Week One

Watch Course Intro video with Pastor Jonathan

Watch “Bubble Creek Canyon Clip”

Discussion Questions:

How many of you lived at Bubble Creek Canyon growing up? How did that shape your view of the world around you?

Read 1 Peter 1:17; 2:13-20; 3:13-17; Colossians 4:5-6 How does a Christ-follower impact culture? Do you think God has strategically placed you exactly where you are (community, school, and work) for maximum “kingdom impact”? Is it hard? Where do you need encouragement?

Watch Video “Engage Humbly” Part 1

Our video teaching suggested 2 ways to consider when engaging with culture:

- Not isolated but impactful; less about location and more about lifestyle.

Read Philippians 2:14-15; Ephesians 5:8-10; Titus 2:12-13. What does this “impactful lifestyle” look like? How are you most challenged?

Read 1 Corinthians 16:13. How is love the cultural “trump” card?

Discussion Questions:

1. Read Daniel 1:1-2 What hint is given that Daniel believed God was in control of who was in control, even if by all counts evil had the upper hand? Does that statement hold true today and if so, what difference does it make to you personally?
2. Read Daniel 6:1-5 What set Daniel apart from the others? What did it cost him? (Read Daniel 6:6-8. What is Daniel’s response? (Read Daniel 6:10-11) And what happened?? (Don’t miss the best ending of all – Read Daniel 6:16-21) What inspires you from this story?
3. “Live in such a way that you are a credit to the Message of Christ.” Philippians 2:15 (Voice) Christians often (not always) repel people from the faith instead of “win” them. “Why? What is lacking in our approach?”

End your study time with sharing prayer needs and praying for each other.
