The Spirit as Gift-giver—Holy Spirit gives gifts to enable us to do what God has called us to do

## What is a spiritual gift?

"A spiritual gift is

a special attribute given by the Holy Spirit to every member of the body of Christ according to God's grace for use within the context of the body." C. Peter Wagner, *Your Spiritual Gifts Can Help Your Church Grow* 

- a special attribute (1Cor 12.4-11, 'to one is given..., and to another...') Not a general characteristic shared by all; each gift is given selectively. Fruit of the Spirit comes in a bundle; gifts are wrapped separately.
- 2. given by the H.S. (1Cor 12.11) He is a gift-giver: i.e., *spiritual* gifts are not the same as natural talents
- 3. to every member of the body of Christ (1Cor 12.7)

Everyone is a specialist; everyone has a role

- 4. *according to God's grace* A gift rather than a merit badge or reward
- 5. *for use within context of body* (1C 12.7: for the common good) If you have a gift, use it for someone else

# What are the spiritual gifts that the Spirit gives?

1Pet 4.11--speaking and serving gifts

# **SPEAKING** gifts

# 1 **Prophecy**

Ability to receive and speak a word from God (not rehearsed) that is for the strengthening of others

Beware of anyone who has a word for you: it is to be judged, not just accepted

## 2 Apostleship

An ability to proclaim the gospel outside of one's home area Like a missionary

## 3 Teaching

Ability to communicate spiritual truth effectively

## 4 Evangelism

Particular ability to witness effectively for Jesus

We are all witnesses, but for some it is a specialty

# 5 Pastoring

Ability to take long-term interest in the spiritual welfare of others

6 Exhortation/Encouragement

Ability to build others up--encouragement and counsel

#### 7 Word of Knowledge

God-given insight to know something not learned But situational; person is not all-knowing

#### 8 Word of Wisdom

God-given insight to know what to do in particular situation

# 9 **Gift of Tongues**

Ability to speak a message from God in an unknown language Pentecostals distinguish between the *gift of tongues*, which is selective, and *speaking in tongues as a sign* of Spirit Baptism

In the first case, tongues is the gift; in the latter, the sign of another gift

## 10 Gift of Interpretation

Ability to interpret a message in tongues interpretation, not translation; not word for word, but conveys a divine thought

# **SERVING gifts**

# 11 Service/Helps

Ability to provide service to the church in supporting role

12 Leadership (1Cor 12.28)

Ability to see what God wants done and motivate others toward it Two kinds: 1. A Visionary; 2. An Administrator (not all leaders are both)

# 13 Giving

An urge to share one's personal resources, whether food, clothing, money

### 14 Showing Mercy

Ability to minister to someone in need, especially the poor

#### 15 Care-giving

Ability to oversee or administer practical care

#### 16 Faith

Ability to believe with unusual confidence in something God will do This is another example of *gift and role*: some are gifted this way, but we all have a measure of faith as believers (role)

#### 17 Discernment

Ability to discern whether someone or something is of divine or demonic influence

## 18 Healing

Ability to pray for people for healing with uncommon success

#### 19 Miracles

Ability to perform miracles that demonstrate the power of God

#### 20 Celibacy

The ability to remain single without undue stress and concern so as to devote oneself more singularly to the work of the Lord (1Cor 7.7)
